



Player Profile – Leslie Kelson



I will say up front that I am addicted to duplicate bridge. I play five or six days a week, at all the local area clubs, and would be happy to play all seven. Like many other people, I played only off and on until recent years. My first exposure was back in 1975, when my beloved Harvey and I had been married for just four years. On a lark, we signed up for classes from Lois Lenhart at the Jewish Community Center. For Harvey, a workaholic as a wholesale distributor and later manufacturer's representative, bridge was a pleasant distraction. For me, it was a passion. With Harvey and with my mother I played some party bridge and some duplicate, at the old Portland Bridge Club on Second and Stark. In 1978, my mother hired Tony Glynne, a professional from England, to give us all private lessons at home. That piqued my interest even more, though my time at the table was limited because of my work at More or Less Collectibles, an antiques store in Multnomah Village that my mother and I co-owned.

My bridge was limited also because Harvey and I spent so many of our evenings dancing. Neither of us danced much before we met, but we made up for lost time in our 44 years together. We danced jitterbug, swing, and blues boogie on the QE2 Jazz Cruise ship and in ballrooms from Portland to Newport, Rhode Island. We danced live to Norman Sylvester, Art Abrams Swing Machine, LaRhonda Steele, Andy Stokes, and others, and enjoyed concerts from artists like Dave Brubeck, Gene Harris, Diana Krall, Diane Schuur, and more. We attended every Gospel Christmas performance at the Oregon Symphony and were lifetime members of the Jazz Society of Oregon. When Harvey fell ill he donated his LP collection, which must have numbered in the thousands, to KMHD.

Then there was football. Harvey was a devoted Ducks fan and alum and we watched every game we could. As born-and-bred Portlanders, we also loved our Blazers and were season-ticket holders for many years, loyal fans for better or worse.

I got back into bridge around 1990, when I sold my share of the antiques store to my mother. Art Gillis kindly offered to act as my mentor, and when my mother sold the store a few years later, she partnered with me as well. Harvey and I played together, too, at Seaside and other special events, and those games are among my fondest memories. We also hosted couples bridge at home with many dear friends.

As my game improved, I expanded my circle of partners. Today there are eight regulars and others with whom I have games scheduled well into 2017. Playing as often as I do has made a big difference in my skill level, but there are still those times that make me wonder if I'll ever truly "get" this game.

What I like best about bridge is unfolding that first hand of the day and knowing I get to do this over and over for the next few hours. Every hand is such a delightful surprise. The thing I like least is the last hand of the day, knowing this glorious experience – being in the company of people I love, testing myself, beating some tough challenges and failing spectacularly at others – will soon be over and I'll have to wait until the following day to begin again.



After the loss of my precious Harvey in 2015, a chasm opened in my heart and threatened to swallow me whole. Bridge, more than anything else, has helped me to close it. What would I do without this wonderful game?
